

No Federal Funding for Nuclear Weapon Tests (100 words)

WHEREAS, moratoriums on nuclear weapons tests are a proven method for preventing environmental damage and reducing the likelihood of nuclear war;

WHEREAS, the US ended nuclear testing in 1992, has signed and ratified three treaties that limit testing, and has previously declared that testing is not in our national interest;

WHEREAS, the Trump administration has now adopted a policy that more easily allows resumption of nuclear testing;

THEREFORE, RESOLVED, that the DPW calls on Wisconsin's congressional delegation to immediately introduce and work to enact legislation barring the use of federal funds for any weapons test that produces a nuclear yield.
