

***Resolution to gather residential data about wood smoke pollution (PM 2.5)***

**Whereas**, reducing air pollution and slowing climate change is popular across the political spectrum,

**Whereas**, Earth Day 1970 energized people to reduce air pollution and united entire populations by positive action,

**Whereas**, residential heat generated by solar, wind, and natural gas produce vastly less PM 2.5 than wood burning, as shown by resident-owned PM 2.5 monitors,
